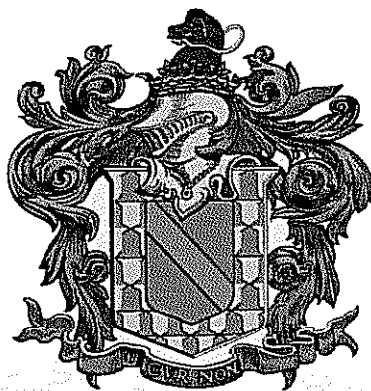

Whites

<i>Chardonnay, Kendall Jackson, California</i> Tropical flavors such as mango and pineapple dance with aromas of peach, apple and pear. Lightly buttered toast headlines the indulgent, lingering finish.	32.00
<i>Chardonnay, Sonoma Cutrer, California</i> Pretty aromas of jasmine and rose petal give way to tropical fruits like pineapple, mango, roasted hazelnut joins nougat and almond butter, finishing with a touch of lime and lychee.	40.00
<i>Chardonnay, "Les Pierres" Sonoma Cutrer, California</i> The wine displays distinct aromas of spice and lemon-lime over a pronounced flinty mineral backbone typical of the vineyard. Signature flavors of green apple and lemon evolve to dried lemon peel and lime zest.	65.00
<i>Pinot Grigio, PIO, Italy</i> Light dry style wine with fresh fruit aromas of peach, pear and lime.	24.00
<i>Pinot Grigio, Culle Duga, Italy</i> Pale yellow full flavored wine with intense flavors of banana and lime blossom	60.00
<i>Pinot Gris, King Estate, Oregon</i> Golden straw with brilliant highlights of ripe peach, sweet grapefruit, orange blossom and tropical fruit.	28.00
<i>Pinot Grigio Verduzzo, Masi Masianco, Italy</i> Complex and attractive on the nose with refreshing hints of citrus fruit and apricots. Delightfully soft and full-bodied, flavours include ripe apples and a slight touch of honey.	28.00
<i>Sauvignon Blanc, White Haven, New Zealand</i> A clean and full flavored medium bodied wine with vibrant current-leaf and gooseberry aromas, some pungent herbaousness nuances and a hint of ripe spice.	32.00
<i>Riesling, Wolf Blass, Australia</i> A pale yellow color with light green hues. The nose shows vibrant varietal aromas of citrus, lemon and lime with a hint of floral character. The elegantly balanced palate displays citrus and intense fruit flavors.	28.00
<i>Riesling, Dr. Fisher, Germany</i> Offers green apple notes with citrus and very fine minerality. Piquant and slightly puckering in the mouth.	36.00
<i>Albarino, Martin Codax, Spain</i> A full-bodied wine with flavors of ripe apples, peach, apricot, melon, grapefruit and lemon zest, melded perfectly together with a bright minerality.	33.00
<i>Verdejo, Esperanza, Spain</i> An intensely aromatic bouquet filled with delicate scent of spring flowers, green apple and white peaches. An intricate play of flavors and textures on the palate with ripe fruit, refreshing acidity and a touch of crisp minerality.	36.00

Red Wines

<i>Merlot, Redwood Creek, California</i>	24.00
This full-bodied wine combines flavors of boysenberries, black cherries and plum jam which are accentuated by spice, chocolate and notes of vanilla. It is well balanced with a long lingering fruit finish.	
<i>Merlot, Red Rock, California</i>	30.00
Lush concentrations of black cherry, plum and boysenberry are complemented by soft, rounded tannins.	
<i>Cabernet Sauvignon, Seven Oaks, J Lohr, California</i>	32.00
An abundance of dark cherry, black currant and berry fruit greets the nose, enhanced by spicy cedar, vanilla and toasty notes. On the palate, the fruit follows through with full weight and a lingering intensity and balance from the tannins.	
<i>Cabernet Sauvignon, Redwood Creek, California</i>	24.00
A round body that combines flavors of fresh blueberries and black cherries that are accentuated by brown spice, mocha and hints of vanilla.	
<i>Cabernet Sauvignon, Ghost Pines, California</i>	44.00
Displays dark fruit jams, bordering on a syrupy character. Aromas of sweet nuts, sweet aromatics and black pepper complement the dark fruit aromas and flavors of this curvaceous wine. The palate is dense and chewy without being overly astringent.	
<i>Pinot Noir, Mirassou, California</i>	28.00
Fresh fruit flavors of pomegranates, cherries and currants with complementing aromas of strawberries, pomegranates and cherries.	
<i>Pinot Noir, MacMurray Ranch, California</i>	36.00
Possesses an expressive fruit character, exhibiting rich aromas of red, blue and black fruits of cherry, ripe blueberries and dark current. The flavors are melded together with earthy notes, balanced perfectly with the nuance of soft vanilla from the oak aging.	
<i>Pinot Noir, Sonoma Cutrer, California</i>	48.00
Aromas of black cherry and currants, quickly followed by notes of cedar and allspice. A strong floral component marries the fruit bouquet. In the mouth the first impression is berries, berries, berries, with raspberry, blueberry and blackberry all enjoying a turn.	
<i>Amarone, Masi, Italy</i>	68.00
Sweet aromas of dried prunes and raisins. Soft and dry on the palate with typical baked cherry flavors mixed with hints of cocoa and cinnamon. Long finishing and full-bodied with soft tannins.	
<i>Chianti, Villa Calcinai, Italy</i>	28.00
This wine has rich flavors that consist of red fruit, mostly cherries, with nuances of oak.	
<i>Campo Ceni, Barone Ricasoli, Italy</i>	32.00
Reveal scents of cherries, chocolate, rosemary and violets. Rich and intriguing flavors ranged from rhubarb and leather to mouth-filling black cherries and cloves. Medium- to full-bodied with a pleasantly bold mouth-feel.	
<i>Pinotage, Simonsig, South Africa</i>	35.00
A sweet raspberry nose with layers of plum. On the palate this full bodied wine brings out the taste of crushed berries.	
<i>Aglianico Taburno, Ocone, Italy (Organic)</i>	40.00
Made in an accessible style that emphasizes an expression of dark berries, spices, minerals and herbs. This wine offers excellent depth as well as purity, with an inviting, fresh finish.	
<i>Modello Delle Venzie, Masi, Italy</i>	28.00
Bright red color of medium intensity. Ripe fruit on the nose, with particular hints of bitter cherries. Attractively fresh on the plate and unexpectedly weighty; plumped out with soft tannins perfectly blended in.	

Red Wine

- Shiraz, Wishing Tree, Australia* 28.00
A medium-bodied Shiraz that shows ample freshness and spice.
- Tempranillo, Martin Codax, Spain* 36.00
An elegant, complex wine with decadent aromas of ripe fruit and a floral bouquet that is integrated with notes of cedar and toasty oak. This is medium bodied with hints of vanilla, cherry, currants, coconut and fresh raspberries.
- Garnacha, Gran Rojo, Spain* 30.00
Intense and pleasant aromas of licorice and wild red and black berries fill the nose, with mineral undertones. Well-rounded and balanced on the palate, it is elegant and fresh. Red fruit, minerals and a hint of fresh thyme linger on the finish. It's surprisingly silky and full-bodied.
- Zinfandel, Ravenswood, California* 28.00
Bright, flashy, ripe raspberry, blackberry and vanilla flavors are wrapped around a soft sweet fruit core highlighted by scents of cinnamon.

Sparkling

- Moscato D' Asti, Pio Cesare, Italy* 42.00
The Moscato d'Asti is a sweet wine, rich in fruit scents, soft and alluring. It is a clear, bright glossy gold yellow color with a ripe fruit and acacia flower bouquet. On the palate, the wine is soft and sweet.
- Champagne, Moet Chandon White Star X Dry, France* 75.00
Intense fruit flavors with crisp acidity and balance.
- Champagne, Perrier Jouet Brut, France* 195.00
Fresh and lively with spiraling bubbles, delicate bouquet, and a subtle complex flavors.
- Champagne, Korbel, California (½ Bottle)* 18.00
Light and crisp, with spicy fruit flavors
